If you wish to make up additional tasks of your own, bonus points will again be rewarded.

Play 'Kim's game'. Put a few items on a tray (e.g. a crayon, an apple, a building brick, a toy car). Then look, cover, remember and check!	Cook something delicious and take a photograph as proof	Learn a new nursery rhyme off by heart	Make a bridge for the gingerbread man to cross the river
Learn a new counting song. Make props to use as you sing it	Hide some treasure and draw a map so that it can be found	Plant a sunflower seed and take a photograph as proof	Draw or paint a picture of your family
Make your own musical instrument and sing along to your favourite song	Build a house for the three little pigs	Go on a colour hunt to find objects that match the shades on the colour chart	Make up a story with you as the main character
