If you wish to make up additional tasks of your own, bonus points will again be rewarded.

Create a puppet show based on a Traditional Tale	Create a marble run – how far can you make your marble travel?	Treasure hunt: hide some treasure and make a map so that it can be found	Create a concept map for a number up to ten
