Play our game of subtraction connect four (visit the school website for the download)	Following on from your 2Do on Purple Mash: write a story or sentence about Little Red Riding Hood's journey to Grandma's house	Make your own set of Numberblocks from 1-11	Go on a nature hunt for sticks, leaves, flowers, pebbles and create a piece of artwork with them 
Make a boat that floats on the water and carries 3 toy people or animals	Make a salt dough decoration. When it is dry, hang it up on your daily walk to make other people smile	Go on a digraph and trigraph hunt. Use the spotters' sheet to tick them off. How many will you spot?	Make a bird to add to your rainbow window display
