Daily Activities

- Reading with an adult** – how many books can you read? Don't forget to keep a record in your planner.

- Maths Fluency** – continue to complete the maths tasks sent home
- Times Tables Rock Stars** – we have set different times tables for you to learn each week.
- Travel to Tokyo Challenge** - continue to keep yourself fit and healthy by exercising every day.

Of the tasks below, choose **three per day**, in any order, to be completed in your home-learning book or on Purple Mash. You can work independently or with a family member. One point will be awarded for each completed task. Tasks in **bold** will be awarded two points. Bonus points will be awarded for creativity, effort and presentation. If you wish to make up additional tasks of your own, bonus points will again be rewarded.

Project: Heroes and Villains

This term, our topic is Heroes and Villains. We will be thinking about superheroes as well as real-life heroes. We will explore what makes someone a hero and why they are important to us or other people.

What materials is their costume made from and why?</i></p>	<p>What makes a superhero? <i>Write six-character traits of a hero. <p>Describe the properties of 3D shapes. <i>Can you identify how many vertices, edges and faces they have? Find at least five 3D shapes in your home. (e.g. dice, football etc)</i></p>	<p>Solve the riddles and number problems. <i>Highlight key language to help you identify which calculation you need to use.</i></p>	<p>Write and perform a poem about Heroes and Villains. <i>What do they look like? How do they behave? Can you include any rhyming words?</i></p>	<p>Create a silly poster about materials. <i>How many silly materials can you think of to make different objects? (a paper hat, a jelly chair etc..)</i></p>
<p>Design a super healthy plate of food for your superhero. <i>Try to include vegetables, carbohydrates, protein and dairy. Label each item and explain how they will help your superhero to keep strong and healthy.</i></p> <p><i>Template provided</i></p>	<p>Create a bird to stick in your window. <i>Take a picture as proof</i></p>	<p>Design a map to help your superhero find a Villain. <i>Use the four compass points (North, East, South and West) and include a detailed key. Use the evaluation sheet to think about what has gone well and what you would do differently next time.</i></p>

Why?</i></p>	<p>Complete Water Woman's reading comprehension. <i>Read the text carefully to correctly answer the questions.</i></p>	<p>Help to make a salad or meal fit for a superhero. <i>Take photos and email them to us.</i></p>	<p>Create a comic strip <i>Make an exciting comic strip about your superhero and villain. What problem does your superhero face and how do they overcome it?</i></p>
