This year's World Book Day will be a little different to usual. We would still like you to be able to celebrate your favourite books and your love of reading so get cosy in some fresh pyjamas and choose from some of these activities and resources below.

Happy World Book Day!

Make a den and share a story with a member of your family.	Retell some nursery rhymes together.	Adult to place objects in a jar or box and help your child to create a story using these objects.
Read some stories by the same author with an adult.	Redesign the front cover of your favourite book.	Share a bedtime story or two before you go to sleep.
Create your own book character.	Get some snacks and watch a film based on one of your favourite books.	Draw/ colour a picture of your favourite book characters and decorate your home.
Retell a classic story using the pictures to help you.	Read a book with a member of your family that makes you laugh.	Act out one of your favourite stories.
Have a teddy bear's picnic and tell your bears a story.	Make a junk model of a story character.	Go on a book hunt and get to read each book you find.
Roleplay based on a favourite story.	Create a snack feast like The Hungry Caterpillar.	Share a book outdoors.
