Happy World Book Day!

Make a den and share a story with a member of your family.	Read to a younger member of the family or pet or be read to by an older member of your family.	Place objects in a jar or box and use these to create your own story.
Read some stories by the same author with an adult.	Redesign the front cover of your favourite book.	Download and listen to an audiobook.
Share a bedtime story or two before you go to sleep.	Recommend a book to a friend – why should they read this book?	Create a bookmark and use it when you are reading.
Create your own book character.	Name the story game. Adult to give clues about a story and you guess what the story is.	Get some snacks and watch a film based on one of your favourite books.
Retell a classic story using the pictures to help you.	Create a book quiz and test your family or friends over video call.	Play charades and act out different books.
Read a book that makes you laugh.	Act out one of your favourite stories.	Draw a picture of your favourite book characters and decorate your home.
