Happy World Book Day!

Make a den and share a story with a member of your family.	Choose a fiction book and a non-fiction book to share that is on the same topic.	Place objects in a jar or box and use these to create your own story.
Drop everything and read, read, read.	Redesign the front cover of your favourite book.	Download and listen to an audiobook.
Share a bedtime story or two before you go to sleep.	Create an advert for one of your favourite books. <i>You could create a poster, record a video or write a review.</i>	Create a bookmark and use it when you are reading.
Create your very own hero or supervillain. It could be based on a story you have read or use your imagination.	Re-write the ending of a story you have at home.	Get some snacks and watch a film based on one of your favourite books.
Retell a classic story by creating a comic strip.	Create a book quiz and test your family or friends over video call.	Play charades and act out different books.
Read a book that makes you laugh.	Read a selection of books written by the same author over the next few weeks.	Host a story telling session and read to your family.
